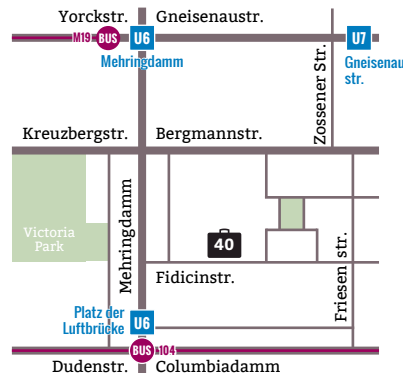

It combines the energy and vitality of improvised theater with the rich biographies and experiences of the actors, who use their own lives as a blueprint for what happens on stage.

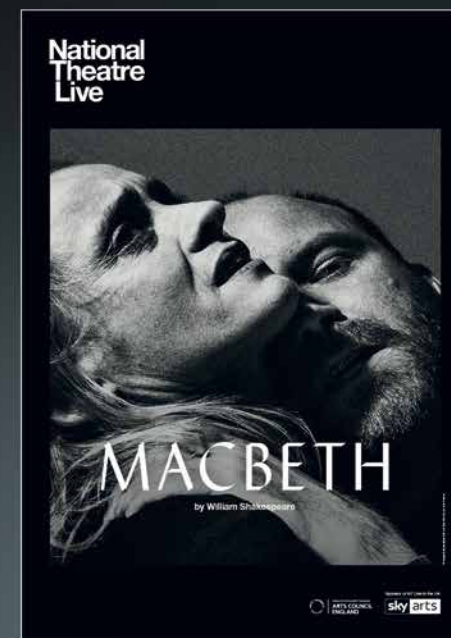

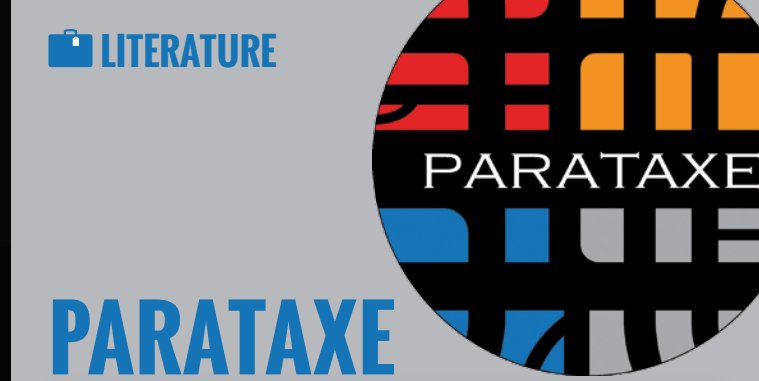
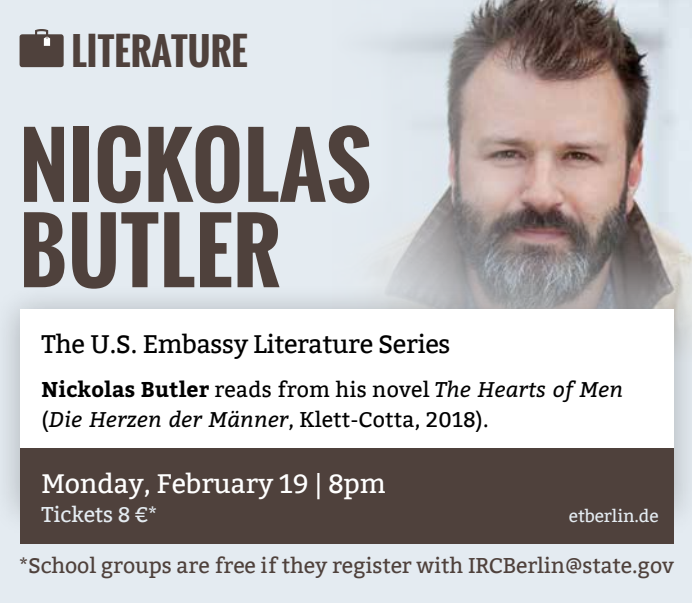

Accompanied by a guitar, a synthesizer and drum machine, *The Kill Joys* sing, scream and perform against daily discriminations and the patriarchy.

Feminism has never been so hip and trendy! We could see this as a true victory for feminism and still post a "I'm a feminist" selfie real quick. Let's be honest. This kind of "high gloss feminism" doesn't cover up the smell of the shit we encounter every day in the form of sexism, racism and every other kind of possible phobia. *I Am Not A Joke (Take Two)* is an appeal against this shit while simultaneously questioning the consumability of feminism.
